Important Reminder About Morning Drop-Off

Dear Parents and Carers,

We kindly remind all families that **the school office entrance must not be used for morning drop-offs** unless there is a **signed and agreed plan** in place with the SENCo and Head Teacher. Only families with such an agreed plan may use the school office for drop-off.

On one day this week alone, **17 families** used the front entrance due to lateness or drop-offs, which resulted in **45 minutes of lost administrative time**. Over the course of a week, this amounts to **3.75 hours**—time that is essential for the smooth running of the school. Additionally, this disrupts learning for all other children in the school as teaching assistants are required to leave classrooms to settle late arrivals.

This situation is no longer sustainable. To support our staff workload and efficiency in running of the office, learning begins at 8.45 and classroom doors open for staggered entry at 8.40 to ensure the day can start promptly at this time.

We appreciate your cooperation in ensuring a smooth start to the school day for everyone.
