Please be reminded of the uniform expectations for your child. Below is an extract from our uniform policy which can be found on our website. Please help us to maintain high standards. Thank you.

10. Our School Uniform is as follows:

- Royal blue school sweatshirt, jumper, or cardigan – *these can be plain or have the school logo*
- White polo shirt
- Grey or black skirt/pinafore dress
- Grey or black tailored trousers
- Grey or black tailored shorts
- Blue/white checked summer dress
- Grey, white or black socks
- Black or grey tights
- Black shoes. *Trainers sandals and boots are not part of our school uniform*
- Wellies
- Hair bands/clips must be school uniform colours only.

11. PE Kit

- Royal blue school sweatshirt, jumper, or cardigan – *Ideally, at least one should be with a school logo.*
- White t-shirt or polo shirt
- Navy or black shorts/skort
- Navy or black jogging/tracksuit bottoms
- For indoor PE children work in bare feet
- For outdoor PE children require trainers in white, black or blue
