On Thursday 9th October we will be holding our annual Harvest Festival at St Mary's Infant School. We would like to invite parents to attend the Harvest festival at 9:15am. Mrs Nice, from St Mary's church, Baldock and our pupils will be leading this service in the school.

The St Albans Diocese is partnering with the charity, Mission Direct, as part of this year's Harvest Appeal.
